

"Guidelines For Club Vested Officials"

DEFINITIONS:

- A Vested Official is the designated club representative at a match.
- Each club with a team participating in a match sanctioned by the Association shall provide one Vested Official for the team. Therefore, there will be two Vested Officials at each match.
- A match includes all fixture premierships, championships, State Titles, six-a-side, and Kath Chandler Memorial Trophy games, the Referees Shield and any other competitions conducted or sanctioned by the Association.
- A Vested Official shall wear the official vest provided by the Association so as it is visible and easily recognisable to all people attending the match.
- A Vested Official must be at least 18 years of age and must not be an on field player.
- A Vested Official is a person who is preferably the most independent person present with the team.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VESTED OFFICIAL:

- To assist the referee in the control of the match, and in particular to maintain appropriate standards of behaviour, by the spectators of his/her team.
- To introduce himself/herself to the referee at least 10 minutes prior to the commencement of the game.
- To welcome the visiting team to the grounds.
- To generally represent the club and the team in all matters.
